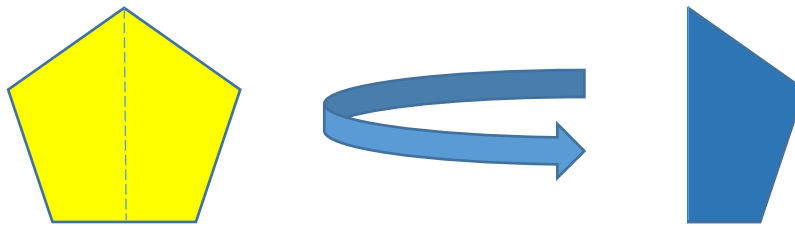


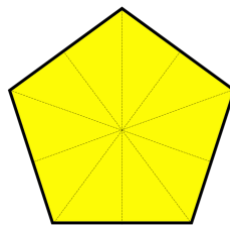
Make Your Own Origami Shooting Star!

Origami is the Japanese art of paper folding. To make your shooting star, you will need to fold two different shapes and join them together. It can be a little tricky, so you might need a grown up to help you.

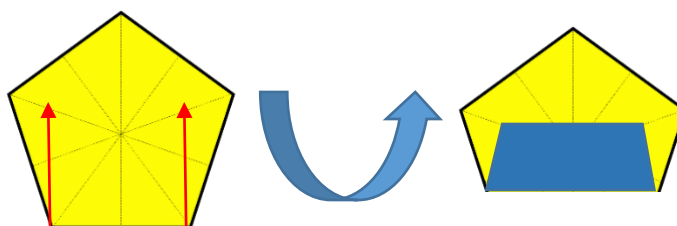
1. First, you will need to print the page with the yellow pentagon and square. Carefully cut these shapes out.
2. Take the pentagon and lay it yellow side down on the table with one of the points facing away from you.
3. Fold the pentagon in half like this:



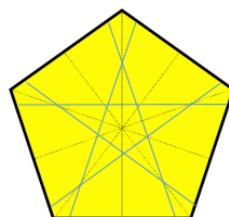
4. Unfold and do the same for each point of the pentagon until you have crease marks all the way round like this:



5. Next, you need to fold the flat bottom edge up. The bottom corners should be lined up with the creases as shown before making the fold:



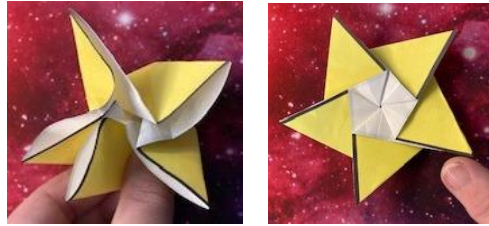
6. Unfold and repeat for each side. This will give you the outline of a smaller pentagon in the middle of your shape.



7. Raise up two sides together, and where they meet, fold outwards to a point. Unfold then do the same for each side, making a point at each of the corners of the pentagon.



8. When you have done this, carefully pull all 5 corners into the points you have just folded, until it starts to look like a star. Press down to flatten.



9. Turn the star over and fold each arm of the star – from the tip of the point to the centre of the star.

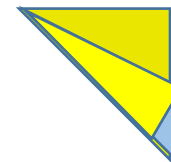


10. Now that your star is complete, take your yellow square and place it face up on the table. Fold it in half (diagonally) with the yellow on the inside.



11. Now take the top corner and fold it to the centre diagonally.

12. Repeat on the other side.



13. Repeat again on both sides and slide point into star. Secure tail with a little sticky tape.



14. Attach star to a stick, pencil, ruler etc. and SWOOSH!
